

## Knights of Columbus Catholic Citizenship Essay Contest 2024-2025 Student Guidelines

## **Eligibility:**

The State Council Contest is open to all Catholic students in grades eight through twelve in public, private, and parochial schools.

## **Essay Theme/Topic:**

Virtue is a habitual and firm disposition to do good. It governs our acts, orders our passions, and guides our conduct by reason and faith. It also encourages Christians to live in a relationship with the Holy Trinity. The call to live a virtuous life applies to individuals in every state of life and occupation, including our elected leaders. In an essay of 500-750 words:

What are the two most important virtues for an elected leader to possess, and why? How can you determine if the leader has these virtues?

## **Guidelines:**

- \*essays must reflect the assigned theme/topic and be submitted by the published deadline to the local K of C Council
- \*essays are to be the student's original work
- \*essays must be typed on 8 1/2" x 11" paper, one sided, double spaced, with 1" margins
- ★essays must be between 500 750 words
- \*students name should appear only on the knights of Columbus Essay Contest Form which should be stapled to the essay, please do not put name on the essay
- \*\* all entries become the property of the Knights of Columbus and will not be returned
- \*deadline for submitting essays is December 15, 2023
